

- 4 provinces: Girona, Lleida, Tarragona and Barcelona






#### Tax Disoccupation 22,7% in Catalunia, Spain 25%

## The School

It is a private school run by a social cooperative whose members are teachers and administrative staff of the school. The lower socio-economic and cultural development of families is medium-high.



## **The School**




Families pay 150 euros/month for compulsory education (6-16) as Catalunia Government gives a contribution to the school. In Batxilerrat which is not compulsory families pay 400 euros/month because there is no State contribution. The school has got 800 students and they are divided in :

- 150 in Infant School (3-6 years old)
- 300 in Primary School (6-12 years old)
- 350 in Secondary School (13-18 years old)

# Students are evaluated at the age of 8, 12 and 16

8 years assessment, diagnostic, subjects: Spanish, Maths, Catalan, written text, teacher internal, 1 day long, online data

**12 years** assessment, **National Test**, subjects: Spanish, Maths, Catalan, English, written and listening text, teacher external, **2 days long** 


assessment, National Test, subjects: Spanis16 years h, Maths, Catalan, English, Science (Technology), written and listening text, teacher external, 3 days long

## Teachers and board evaluation

Teachers are evaluated by the Board of Directors through inteviews based on parents questionnaires and structural and personal objectives.

The Board of Directors is evaluated by the Executive Board through questionnaires and structural objectives.

School organization is evaluated by families, too.



#### **External evaluation**



School evaluation is once in a year according to the Head Master. There is an A.V.A.C. (Avaluaciò Anual de Centres) inspector who visits the school for a whole day
